



BALLET SOUTH VARIATIONS & CHOREOGRAPHIC WORKSHOP JUNE 19 - 30 age 10+

For the first time, during this exclusive two-week long workshop, students will be challenged to expand their technical and artistic abilities and to explore various approaches to the creative process. This workshop will guide students through competition variations and choreographic creations and will offer them an insight into the professional dance world with its etiquette and expectations. The choreographic exploration portion, will focus on learning structural themes and physical codes through the study of a choreographer's phrasing. During ballet and contemporary classes, students will be asked to investigate the various physical and emotional layers involved in the personification of a character. Over the course of the two weeks, participants will be encouraged to embrace their own creativity. They will also acquire a better understanding of the choreographic process. This workshop will add depth to the students' interpretation and maturity to their dancing as well. These two intensive weeks will also prepare the dancers for their next competition. A performance will be held on the last day of the program at Cullman Art Park at sunset. The performance will be free and open to the public.
